Logan Lucky takes place in West Virginia in the present day. Jimmy Logan gets fired from his job of doing construction underneath the Charlotte Motor Speedway. Jimmy visits his young daughter, who is in custody of Jimmy's ex-wife and her rich husband. Jimmy's ex-wife explains that they are moving to open a new car dealership in Virginia. Jimmy goes to the bar that his brother, Clyde Logan works at. Clyde lost his arm while serving in Iraq, but manages to have a job as a bartender. Jimmy explains his plan to rob the Charlotte Motor Speedway. Jimmy explains that there is a tube that carries all the cash earned from the races to a vault that they can rob. Clyde reluctantly agrees and the pair recruit Joe Bang, a safe-cracker who is in jail for breaking into vaults and stealing money, their sister Mellie, and Joe's two unintelligent brothers. Clyde drives a car through a building on purpose, not hurting anyone and not causing too much damage, to get himself into the same prison as Joe. This is to break Joe out, and to give them an alibi in case of suspicion. However, while Jimmy is scouting out the stadium under the cover of visiting his old job, he learns that construction was finished ahead of schedule and that the group will have to rob the much bigger race one week earlier than planned. Joe and Clyde ask an inmate to stage a prison riot, and Joe pretends to get sick so that he and Clyde can escape through the much less guarded medical wing. Mellie drives the pair to the stadium where Joe's brothers disable the credit card scanners, so that everyone will have to use cash. They meet up with Jimmy, and Joe uses a makeshift explosive to take out the locked gate to the tube room. They disconnect the tube and suck all the money into large garbage bags. Joe's brothers take the money to Jimmy's truck and Clyde and Joe sneak back into the prison, nobody suspecting that they were gone during the chaos. Jimmy leaves the money and anonymously informs the police where it is. The rest of the group is mad, but it turns out Jimmy kept a few trash bags, and he gives them out to the group. The FBI starts an investigation, but between the lack of evidence, the money being returned and the prison warden not reporting the riot, the investigation is closed. Jimmy gets a new job and buys a house near his daughter.

Joe's two brothers set off a small bomb to disable all motorway employee cards and they all meet up at the vault. There, all the money is for their taking and it's up to them to steal it and not get caught.
