Shooom's Odyssey is about a baby owl and her brother, who is still in an egg, who have to leave their nest after it blows away in a storm. The sister owl interacts with several other types of animals, starting with a squirrel who had tried taking shelter in their nest during the storm. Sister owl tries to bond with these various animals, possibly because she thinks they're her mother, but they all reject her. Toward the middle of the film, the owl and egg get separated because the sister gets her brother's egg mixed up with an alligator egg.
